Non-charitable Grants 2024-25

Non-charitable Major Project grants

Most of our funding for major projects is charitable, however in 2024-25, as part of the Fossil Fuels and Insurance major project, we funded non-charitably:

Mothers Rise Up a grassroots campaign group who combine specialist skills and creativity to fight for climate justice, and our funds will enable work focusing on insurance of fossil fuel investments.

Non-charitable Pools grants

Generally one-off funding from £8,000 up to £25,000. There is one round per year. Non-charitable Pools grants in 2024-25 were:

Abdullah Dzinamarira Foundation Trust Addressing the barriers climate change poses to providing education and social support for underprivileged and vulnerable children in Sanyati District, Zimbabwe

Black SEN Mamas (SEN Mamas CIC) Offering 12-week mental health and advocacy support, including 1:1 counselling, workshops, support groups, mindfulness, and SEND legal advocacy

Declassified UK Core funding towards work examining the UK role in support of Israel in its war on Gaza

Democracy for Sale The Watchdog is a new project at the intersection of journalism, law and campaigning that is dedicated to the public's right to know

Independent Ecological Expertise in Kyrgyzstan Training representatives of local communities in the protection of citizens' rights in the Kyrgyz Republic, in the field of environmental protection

International Climate Change Development Initiative Africa Enhancing the knowledge and understanding of young climate activists in Nigeria, Ghana, and Gambia on climate justice issues, and building a regional network of young climate activists

Shadow World Investigations Researching the global trade in weapons for a book and documentary 'Making a Killing - How the West profits from slaughter in Yemen and Gaza'

Stop Fuelling War Developing alternatives to the way 'security' is viewed in France and wider Europe, to encompass non-violent, non-aggressive and sustainable rather than militaristic solutions

Sunbula Building the economic resilience of craft producer groups in the West Bank and Gaza

Union of Justice Empowering emerging leaders of colour across 10 European countries to address climate justice and racial equity

Non-charitable Fast Track grants

Generally one-off funding of £5,000 – £8,000. In 2024-25 we awarded 19 non-charitable Fast Track grants through 4 funding rounds. Grants were:

Active Hope CIC Empowering thousands worldwide, through an online course helping people to grow their capacity for engagement in achieving positive social change

Amazon Watch Campaign to halt the Ferrograo, an environmentally destructive infrastructure project in the Brazilian Amazon

Climate Camp Scotland A camp for climate justice movement building and non-violent direct action against the fossil fuel industry

Climate Choir Movement Core costs to support singers performing eco-themed songs together outside or inside the institutions that are funding or facilitating the climate crisis

Earth Tenders C.I.C An urban food-growing space and community hub, where Black, people of colour, queer, migrant and low-income individuals can train in land-based practices

Earth Thrive Researching the forest biomass industry in Serbia, to support a future campaign against the proliferation of highly damaging biomass industry in the region

Flooded People UK Building a social movement of flooded people to influence policy

Lakenheath Alliance for Peace (LAP) Running talks, workshops and non-violent training, and encouraging national and international campaigners to participate in the LAP Camp and Conference

Make Hope Possible Limited Aiming to restore truly local government to Scotland through the 'Build a Local Scotland' campaign

Make Votes Matter Supporting a youth movement in support of fair votes and proportional representation

Safe Landing Developing a communications campaign to raise awareness of the community of aviation workers and enthusiasts who care about the future of the industry and our planet

Say NO to incineration Supporting a Judicial Review of an Environmental Permit for an 'energy from waste' incinerator in the Ryburn valley in West Yorkshire

Somerset Storyfest Delivering the One Tree (Many Branches) project, for refugees to tell their life stories in schools

SOS for Sudan Supporting Sudanese asylum seekers by teaching them English, providing emotional support and a weekly Sudanese meal

Steppers Women of Colour over 40 Walking Football Group To improve physical fitness, advocate and enhance mental health and well-being through walking football

Stir To Action Developing a vision for the future of social clubs, through case studies and roundtables, to help prevent any further loss of UK clubs & institutes

The STEMinist Foundation Ghana Building the voices of rural women and children to defend their rights to access electricity along the Volta Lake, Ghana

Tottenham Rights Construction and development of a digital archive for the War Inna Babylon project, fighting for racial justice in Britain since 1948

Workforce Movement Aiming to increase the minimum wage to £15 per hour, using a powerful digital campaign to amplify the voices of low-waged workers across the UK
